While I do not necessarily advocate spaying and neutering your weird friends and relatives, I do advocate spaying and neutering your pets. In fact, after spending decades watching wonderful dogs and cats be killed just because nobody wanted them, I consider allowing one's pets to reproduce tantamount to a crime. The fact is that when people allow their pets to reproduce they are actually killing homeless pets because the people that adopt from their litter will not be adopting homeless pets.

People who let their pets reproduce should go to their local animal control shelter and watch homeless cats and dogs being killed (albeit "humanely"). It is a sickening sight which is caused by people who do not spay and neuter their pets. This is an ugly situation to be sure, but people need to recognize it so that it can be stopped.
